Category: Cross-organisation Working to Deliver Research

This award is open to people who have used innovative approaches to deliver an NIHR Portfolio study/studies by working across organisational boundaries. Examples could be primary and secondary care joint working, researchers working with local authorities, joint working between the NHS and Care Homes, researchers working with a community organisation or charity, delivering studies across regions.

The entry criteria for **Cross-organisation Working to Deliver Research** are:

1. Is this an NIHR portfolio study listed?
2. Is there more than one organisation involved in study delivery?
3. Was an innovative approach used to deliver the trial?
4. How effective was this approach (evidence given)?
5. Did this approach support access to research in under-served communities?
6. Can this approach be used to support research in the future?
7. Is there evidence of shared learning?

The deadline for entries is 25th November 2022
